As we look forward to our 53rd year of teaching sailing on beautiful Pleasant Bay, we are pleased to welcome some new and returning staff members to our crew. New Hampshire native, Haley Cedarholm, will be joining us as new head instructor. Currently a student at the University of Rhode Island, Haley crews for the URI Sailing Team. She has also instructed sailing at the UNH Community Sailing Center in Barrington, NH. Other new staff members include, Diana Haemer, and junior instructors, Emma Casey and Meghan Diamond. Harrison Ellis will also be returning as an instructor this summer. All of our instructors are highly qualified; our senior instructors have completed their Launch Tender, CPR, First Aid and US Sailing Level 1 Instructor certifications.

This year we are excited to announce that in addition to lessons and rentals, Arey's Pond Boat Yard plans to provide a launch service for our mooring customers. Our launch service will be offered from 10am to 6pm seven days a week.

As in past years we will have private lessons for all ages offered by appointment every day from 9 AM to 6 PM. Our weekly group lessons for ages 8-18 will be offered as well. Group lessons will run Monday through Friday from 9:30 to 11:30 AM at the rate of \$240 a week. Our group classes will maintain a low student to instructor ratio. Students will learn the basics of sailing, as well as knot tying, safety procedures, navigation and racing. Instructors will provide hands-on instruction tailored to individual students' needs. This will include challenging more experienced students to learn more advanced skills. Light homework, accompanied by an instructional handbook, will be assigned to help students understand the concepts that have been introduced each day. In addition to our fleet of Arey's Pond 14' Catboats, we also have an Arey's Pond Daysailer available for those who would like to learn to sail a larger boat with both a main and jib sail.

Arey's Pond will continue to offer our rental program, featuring a variety of vessels including Arey's Pond Catboats, Daysailers, Peapod rowboats, kayaks and paddleboards. In cooperation with Supfari Adventures, we will also be offering paddleboard instruction and rentals on the Namequoit River. Our rentals are available everyday from 9 AM until 4 PM; reservations are recommended.

If you have previously attended our sailing school or used our rental program, we want to hear your feedback! Please let us know how we can create a more enriching experience. It is our goal to foster our students' appreciation of sailing, the coastal waters, and the world of boating while aiming to challenge all students to improve their skill level. To ensure that our returning sailors continue to be challenged by our program, please describe your sailing experience and goals in as much detail as possible on the registration form so that we can tailor each week's program to the individual sailors enrolled.

The 2017 season is shaping up to be another fun-filled time on the bay.
