We hope that this letter finds you well and we look forward to welcoming you back to the sailing school program this summer. Haley Cedarholm will return as Head Instructor and Program Director and Diana Haemer and Harrison Ellis will be returning as Instructors. With another year of experience under our belts, we know that this will be the best summer yet and we can't wait to get out on the bay with our students.

I am excited to announce that we are making some improvements to our program. Our group lessons for students ages 8-18 will continue to be held from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m., five days a week with an updated curriculum. The new curriculum will include skill-building opportunities for our intermediate and advanced students, as well as new drills and activities to make sure that our returning students continue to be challenged through new experiences that enhance their sailing proficiency. Group lessons will begin in the last week of June.

Our private lessons for students of all ages will continue this summer. Private lessons are a great way for kids and adults to get out on a sailboat for the first time, build upon previous skills, learn how to sail their new Catboat or just experience Pleasant Bay. Private lessons are available by appointment only, seven days a week from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and typically last for two hours.

The APBY launch service will continue to operate this summer for our mooring customers. The service will be available starting on Memorial Day and will run daily from 9am to 5pm. This summer you can contact the launch by hailing us on channel.

We are also excited to announce our first Women's Group Lesson program. Boating is a male-dominated activity and we're excited to provide a space for women to learn to sail or improve their skills with other women. This program will be open to all women over the age of 18, regardless of experience. It will be offered from 4 to 6 p.m. a few weeknights a month. Dates for the group lesson will be released in June.

Our rental program will continue this summer. Catboats, kayaks, paddleboards and rowboats will be available for rent from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. In cooperation with Supfari Adventures we will be offering paddle board instruction and rentals on the Namequoit River.

2018 is shaping up to be another fun-filled year on the bay. We have already received registrations, so in order to ensure that you are able to reserve the time that is best for you we recommend that you sign up now!
